### So Far This Year...

- NAMA funded training for our new drum majors over the summer. We also helped 5 students attend summer music camps.
- NAMA funded stipends for our talented technical staff who help teach the NAHS marching band members the drill they perform at football games and competitions.
- NAMA volunteers helped support the Marching Band throughout the season with countless chaperone hours, uniform purchase, distribution, collection, and repair, a band camp barbeque, and the production of a successful and profitable NESBA Marching Band Competition that welcomed 12 bands and hundreds of spectators to our town.
- NAMA volunteers helped support the chorus tailgate party for our chorus members who perform the National Anthem at each football game with such talent and poise.
- NAMA purchased additional dresses and tuxedos to outfit a Concert Choir of over 150 participants.
- NAMA and the North Andover High School hosted the Northeast Senior District auditions, including a profitable concession stand at the event.
- NAMA funded new microphones and sound system equipment for the Elementary Band program.

NAMA led an effort to raise over \$10,000 to purchase a new baby grand piano and a dolly system to allow the instrument to be transported around the school as needed.
