> The minutes from the June 19, 2018 meeting were approved.

### Treasurer's Report

- Net income for the year AY17-18 was \$7,116.
- 109 band students have completed paperwork and received invoices; 33 are paid in full.
- We have received \$1,250 contributions on \$3,200 pledges.
- Check your corporate matching opportunities! The "Intel Involved Volunteer Matching Grant" program contributed \$860.
- > The treasurer's report was approved.

## **Chorus Director's Report (via email)**

- There are two checks in the main office for \$400 that should be put toward repayment of the loan for AY17-18.
- Chorus Camp will be Wednesday, August 22 from 10-12 (concert choir) and 12-1:30 (treble choir) and Thursday, August 23 from 10-12 (concert choir) and 12-1 (scarlet & black). It is not mandatory and will really be an opportunity for new students to be able to become acquainted with some of the returning members, to make some friends before school starts, and to voice test before school starts. Sara will meet with officers and section leaders when she's back from vacation to discuss the details.
- Sara is working on the Chorus Handbook and will have it ready after her vacation.
- Hannah Carroll is working with Kim Hearst on NA Music water bottles. We are considering making them part of the uniform fee for everyone or selling them separately as a fundraiser for the trip. Regardless, we are considering a policy of only allowing the NA Music water bottles on stage for aesthetic and noise issues.
- The fall rehearsal schedule is not set yet. Sara will talk with the small groups at camp to figure out which day of the week works best for rehearsal days.

# **Old Business**

- NAMS Fall Meeting it was brought up that we should hold one of our monthly NAMA meetings at NAMS to encourage NAMS parent participation. Since many of the fall meetings will be dedicated to marching band, NESBA and Knight to Remember, Kristine suggested adding a separate meeting to discuss items specific to NAMS. Kristine will contact Andrea, Chris, and Matt to identify a good night.
