NAMA MUSIC STIPEND APPLICATION

North Andover Music Association has money available to help with the cost of tuition or application fees for NAPS music students attending music honors programs or music training programs. Costs may include application fees or tuition.

Stipends are separate from the North Andover Music Association Scholarship program which is meant to assist with college costs. Stipend Amounts: Stipend amounts depends on the availability of funds and may vary from year to year or from program to program.

Process: Student must submit a Stipend Application and describe the program and the fee/tuition required. Parent and teacher should sign the form. Music teacher should forward the form to the Stipend Committee of NAMA.
