Basic Necessities:

Money for lunch on Thursday (after we get off the plane) and Friday (at the zoo), and any souvenirs
Cell phone and cell phone charger to call chaperones/ parents
Toiletries (**deodorant**, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, hair brush, **deodorant**)
Homework for the plane/ at hotel
Snacks for hotel/ plane. **NO PEANUT/ NUT PRODUCTS as we have students on our trip with life-threatening airborne allergies.**
Sunscreen (if needed)

CHOIRS:

Tuxedo Wearers:

- Tuxedo pants
- Tuxedo shirt
- Tuxedo vest
- Tuxedo jacket (Scarlet and Black and Treble Choir Only)
- Black socks
- Black dress shoes
- Red tie
- Hair pulled back off face (if applicable)

Dress Wearers:

- Chorus Dress
- Red Ribbon
- FLAT black dress shoes
- Black tights
- Pearls (S&B only)
- Red flower (TC only)
- NO OTHER JEWELRY besides STUD earrings
- Hair pulled back off face (if applicable)

BANDS:

Gentlemen:

- Black dress shirt (black sport jacket Wind Ensemble Only)
- Black dress pants (NO JEANS)
- Black dress belt
- Black socks
- Black dress shoes (most wear black marching shoes)

Ladies:

- Black dress, black blouse and black skirt, or black blouse and black dress pants
- Sleeves may be medium length or longer (no sleeveless tops)

Dress or skirt must be mid calf or longer
Pants should be long
Black closed toe dress shoes (comfortable heel height for walking on and off stage)
Jewelry- small necklace and/or earrings may be worn. NO bracelets.

Please note that all band/ choir students may wear their choir uniform for the band performance!

Musical Items:

Choirs:

Honor Choir music in NICE BLACK BINDER (if applicable)
Music Department Water Bottle

Bands:

Flutes- if room, pack instrument in suitcase. MUSIC.
Clarinets- 3 extra reeds, cork grease, MUSIC
Double Reeds- extra reed, MUSIC
Saxophones- neck strap, 3 extra reeds, cork grease, MUSIC
Trumpets, Trombones, Euphonium, Tuba- mouthpiece, valve oil, any mutes needed for the pieces, MUSIC
Percussion- MUSIC, Suspended cymbal and stand, concert snare drum and stand, crash cymbals, congas and stand, tambourine, darbuka, triangle and beater, all necessary mallets and sticks (concert snare, bass drum, gong, timpani, vibes, marimba, chimes, xylophone)

Medications:

Prescription medications must be kept in original packaging with a note from parents.

For safety, please only bring the amount needed for the duration of the trip. One additional day may be brought in case of flight cancellation.

Students needing epi-pens and other life-saving medications should carry them on their person at all times.

Students should be responsible for holding and administering their own medications on this trip. If this is an issue, please contact our school nurse, Lauren McDonald, who is attending our trip and she will discuss it with you.

Advil and other over-the-counter medicines can be held without a note.

Do not bring expensive items!

Reminders:

Students may bring one carry-on suitcase and one personal item (backpack, purse, etc.).

Only carry-on size luggage is allowed. Please visit your airline's website for dimensions.

Make sure there are name tags on all suitcases and instruments containing your first and last name, address, and phone number.

Please be practical about what you bring. No large sums of money, expensive items, etc.
